# Jane Hall Resume

I attended school at Dursley Grammar School in Gloucestershire UK and from there went on to study Veterinary Medicine at Glasgow University. I graduated in 1975 with a Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine and Surgery degree. I served on the Students Representative Council for 3 years.

I worked for a year in UK and then emigrated to South Africa in 1976. I worked at the Blue Cross Veterinary Hospital in Newlands, Cape Town for 3 years. I married my late husband in 1979 and we moved to Benoni in the then Transvaal where we lived for the next 37 years. I worked at Mercury Street Veterinary Hospital firstly as an assistant, then as a partner and lastly as a sole owner. I ran the practice for 30 years.

I served on the Governing Body of Benoni Junior School as parent representative for 5 years.

I served on the 9<sup>th</sup> Benoni Scout Group committee for approximately 6 years. I was an approved examiner for cub and scout interest badges. I was involved with the organisation of the Scouting Kontiki Competition in Gauteng for many years.

I was a qualified Show Jumping judge and oversaw shows at local and provincial level.

I have been involved with SA Guide Dogs from 1995. In that time I have raised and puppy-walked 6 dogs, of which 4 have graduated to be working guide dogs for the blind or service dogs for disabled people. The other 2 dogs were taken out of the program for medical reasons.

I started playing golf only when I was well into my 50's. I joined Benoni Country Club and served on the Ladies Committee there until I retired and we relocated to Cape Town in 2017.

I joined the Ladies Committee in 2019 taking over the Finance Portfolio. I became Vice-Captain in 2024 when Anne Keable took over the Captaincy.
